### Series Record:

ASU leads the series, 44-7. San Diego State leads the series, 70-45-1 record, dating back to 1957. The lone tie, 7-7, came in 1986 due to a time limit at the Best in the West Classic at Fresno, Calif. The first nine games of the Cougar-Aztec series were played in San Diego before SDSU came to Provo twice in 1979.

### Coach Vance Law

Coach Vance Law logged his 600th game at the BYU helm last month and earlier this month was presented a Cougar Paw Award (citing service) by the BYU Athletic Department in its quarterly meetings. Law is in his 11th season as head coach at BYU. He played 14 years of pro ball, including 11 years in the majors with six different teams. In 2001 he was named Coach of the Year in the Mountain West Conference. The 53-year-old coach entered this season with a 317-263-2 (.546) record. He is assisted by Ryan Roberts, in his eighth year at BYU. Pitching coach Bobby Applegate is in his seventh year with BYU, having last coached at the Air Force Academy.

**Oldest to Youngest**

There are eight seniors and eight freshmen on the current squad. The ages range from 24-year-old Kevin Sloan to 18-year-old Kevin Noall.

**Strength of Schedule**

Boyd's World collegiate baseball rankings had BYU ranked with the 31st toughest schedule in the nation. Others on BYU's schedule were ranked on that strength of schedule index: Washington State (18), San Francisco (23), Arizona State (30) and TCU (53). Pingbaseball has BYU at No. 17 on schedule difficulty, while Seattle is No. 1, followed by San Diego State (24) and New Mexico (50)

**Good GPAs**

Sophomore pitcher David Parry recorded a 4.0 grade point average last semester. The accounting major made the Dean's List. Another of the top GPAs on the team is by pitcher Shawn Hardesty, who has a job teaching Portuguese at the nearby Missionary Training Center. Kevin Sloan and Dane Nielsen were nominated to the CoSida Academic All-America ballot.

**Home Season**

BYU drew 19,474 fans in it's 21-game home schedule last season for an average of 927 with a 8-13 record. The Cougars have a 133-64 (.675) record at Larry H. Miller Field which seats 2,204 fans in its 10th season since it was built. In the previous nine years BYU has drawn 218,981 fans for an average of 1,177 and 142,248 at night for an average of 1,452. Last season BYU has drew 18,650 fans at home (1,036 avg.), but a couple of the 18 games were not paid admission. The crowd of 3,081 against Utah last season was the fourth-largest in school history and the second-largest at Miller Park. This season the largest crowd at home was 1,826 in the finale vs. Utah and the crowd of 3,744 fans on the road at Utah Valley.

**Taking Series**

BYU has now won series against UC Davis, Washington, UNLV, San Jose State, No. 20 Kansas State and Utah. The Cougars have won on every trip since the opening series and the first week of May.

**Zimbabwe**

Coach Vance Law, his son Andrew, Wes Guenther, David Parry and Stephen Wells assisted others in the community in packing clothing and supplies in crates which arrived in January to assist those in need in Zimbabwe. Coach Law became aware of this project through his son Adam, who was on last year's team, and is now serving a mission there.

**NCAA Statistics**

Jonathan Cluff was ranked 12th nationally in triples, while the Cougars were ranked eighth in that category. Kevin Sloan was ranked 21st nationally in victories.

BYU's baseball (Larry H. Miller Field)-softball (Gail Miller Field) complex known as Miller Park was host to three "doubleheaders" this season. On April 22, softball hosted UNLV, while baseball hosted Utah; on April 23, softball hosted San Diego State, while baseball again hosted Utah in a TV game; on April 24, softball again hosted SDSU, while baseball again hosted Utah.

**Regarding BYU This Season**

- BYU has nine players who are married (Nick Birch, Alex Hancock, Shawn Hardesty, Brandon Michon, Matt Neil, Dane Nielsen, Brandon Relf, Kevin Sloan and Alex Wolfe).
- Incorporated into this year's team are five players who have just finished serving two-year Church missions (Chase Frampton, Wes Guenther, Austin Hall, David Parry and Stephen Wells).
- Four players transferred to BYU (Ryan Bernal, Nick Birch, Alex Hancock and Coltin White).
- Among those who could throw batting practice to BYU again this season is former Cy Young winner Vernon Law (1960 Pittsburgh Pirates), father of BYU head coach Vance Law. Vernon turned 80-years-old on March 12 of 2010 and had seven-by-pass heart surgery five years ago.

**Wolfe two-time MWC Player of Week & CollegeBaseballInsider.com Regional Player of Week**

Sophomore Alex Wolfe homered the first four home games last month, with multiple RBI in each of those games. He had the game-winning RBI with a two-run double in BYU's 16-4 romp over Washington--in that game he doubled and hit a two-run homer for four RBI in that 13-run second inning. In game one vs. Washington as a first baseman, he had a diving rollover assist on the first batter in the fifth inning to complete the putout to the pitcher. He was on the end of five double plays in game two vs. Washington. He had a slugging average of 1.556 for the three-game series.

Against Utah he accounted for both of BYU's game-winning RBI with a walk-off homer in the finale. That opposite field two-run homer with two out in the ninth gave BYU a 6-4 win on a 1-1 count. In that game he played at third base and stopped Utah's rally in the eighth when he cut off a throw from left field to catch a Utah runner between bases for a 7-5-6 putout to end that inning with another runner on base after the Utes had scored their fourth run. In game one vs. Utah he played at first base and had a two-run double down the right field line with two outs and a 2-2 count, not counting fouling off two pitches to give BYU an 8-7 lead. He scored BYU's ninth run in that eighth inning. In that 9-7 game he was on base in each of his five trips to the plate, including being hit by a pitch. Both game-winning RBI came off pitches from Utah reliever Zach Adams, whom he coached last summer. Wolfe had a slugging percentage of .909 for the week and an on-base percentage of .643. He raised his batting average from .321 to .338. He is batting .400 in league games with a .783 slugging percentage and an on-base percentage of .478.
